Goals and Objectives

- Improve reading by providing students with familiar, predictable language.
- Increase confidence in reading and writing through successful, scaffolded writing experiences
- Increase purposeful writing through the use of symbols to enhance word pairing in the presence of significantly delayed spelling skills
- Increase mean length of utterance (verbal or using AAC device)
- Improve navigation skills on AAC device page sets
- Increase vocabulary comprehension through exposure to new topics and exploration of familiar topics
